1 RULES

- 1.1 The event is governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) 2025-2028*. The Prescriptions of the RNWA can be found at [World Sailing - Racing Rules of Sailing](#)
- 1.2 The '[Rules for \(Open\) Championships Sailing, Windsurfing and Kiteboarding](#)' will apply.
- 1.3 Racing rule(s) RRS A2.1 will be changed: see NoR 15.3 . The sailing instructions may change other rules as well.
- 1.5 If there is a conflict between languages the text in the English language will take precedence.
- 1.6 Every person on board who has his domicile in the Netherlands shall have the appropriate license.

- 1.9 RRS Appendix T, Arbitration, applies.

3.2 [DP] All boats shall carry a VHF radio capable of communicating on channel 88.

4 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

4.1 The event is open to all boats of the H-boat class.

4.4 Eligible boats may enter by completing the subscription in [Manage2sail](#) by June 3th 23:59 hours.

4.5 To be considered an entry in the event, a boat shall complete all registration requirements and pay all fees.

4.6 No late entries will be accepted.

5.1 Entry fees €200,00 (two hundred euro's) per boat entrée.

9.2 Equipment inspection and event measurement:

Competitors shall be available with their boat on June 4th from 09:00 until 18:00 hrs at the boat yard of the WSV Hoorn Julianapark 1 1621 MR Hoorn.

10 EQUIPMENT INSPECTION

10.1 Each boat shall produce or verify a valid measurement certificate.

10.2 [DP] Boats shall be available for equipment inspection at any time.

10.3 Any equipment may be inspected or measured, to be determined by the technical committee.

10.4 [DP] Boats shall also comply with RRS 78.1 when presented for inspection.

14 PENALTY SYSTEM

15 SCORING

15.1 The scoring system is as follows: Four races are required to be completed to constitute a championship. This changes RRS A2.1.

15.2 (a) When 4 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.

(b) When 5, 6, or 7 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

15.3 RRS 90.3(e) applies, only for the final results.

18 [DP] BERTHING

18.1 Boats shall be kept in their assigned places in the WSV Hoorn harbour assigned by the harbour master.



19 [DP] HAUL-OUT RESTRICTIONS

- 19.1** Boats shall not be hauled out during the regatta except with and according to the terms of prior written permission of the race committee.

20 [DP] DIVING EQUIPMENT AND PLASTIC POOLS

- 20.1** Underwater breathing apparatus and plastic pools or their equivalent shall not be used around keel boats between the preparatory signal of the first race and the end of the event.
- 20.2** Keelboats shall not be cleaned below the waterline by any means from June 5th 08:00 hours until after the last race of the event.

21 RISK STATEMENT

- 21.1** RRS 3 states: 'The responsibility for a boat's decision to participate in a race or to continue to race is hers alone.' By participating in this event each competitor agrees and acknowledges that sailing is a potentially dangerous activity with inherent risks. These risks include strong winds and rough seas, sudden changes in weather, failure of equipment, boat handling errors, poor seamanship by other boats, loss of balance on an unstable platform and fatigue resulting in increased risk of injury. Inherent in the sport of sailing is the risk of permanent, catastrophic injury or death by drowning, trauma, hypothermia or other causes.
- 21.2** The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

22 INSURANCE

- 22.1** Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of Euro 1.500.000 or the equivalent per incident.

23 PRICES

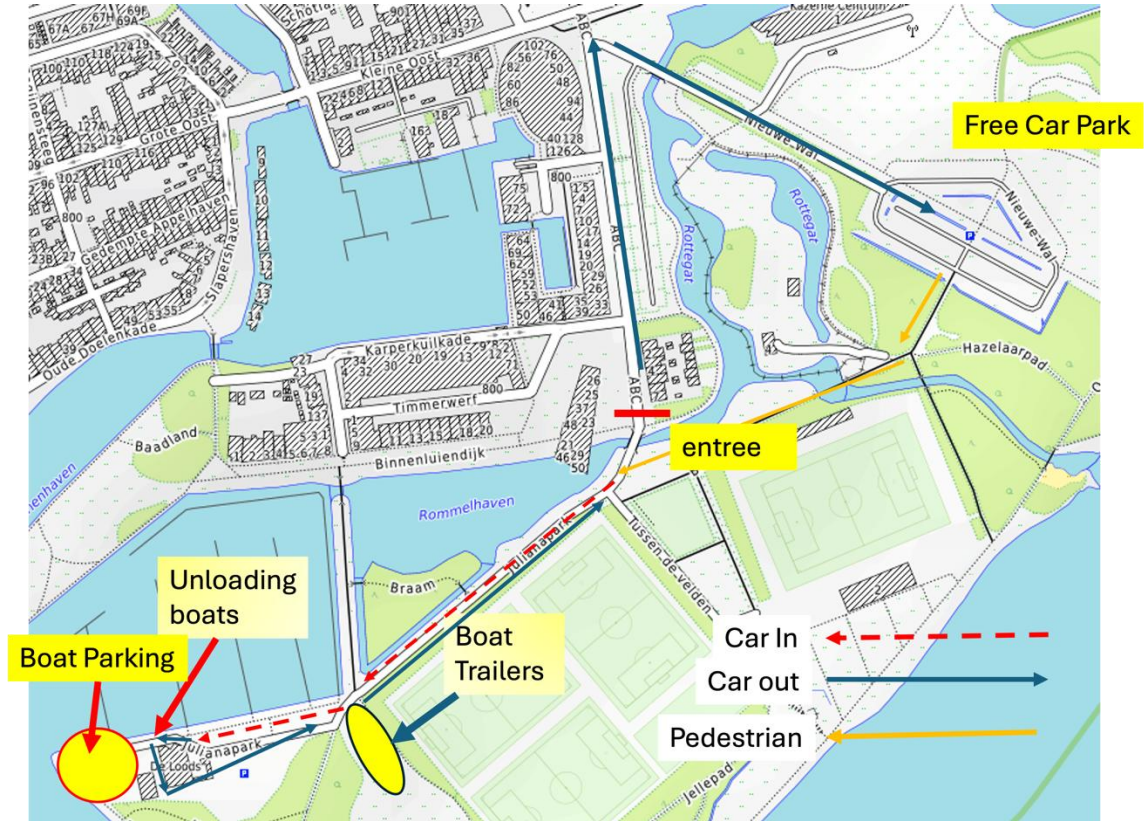

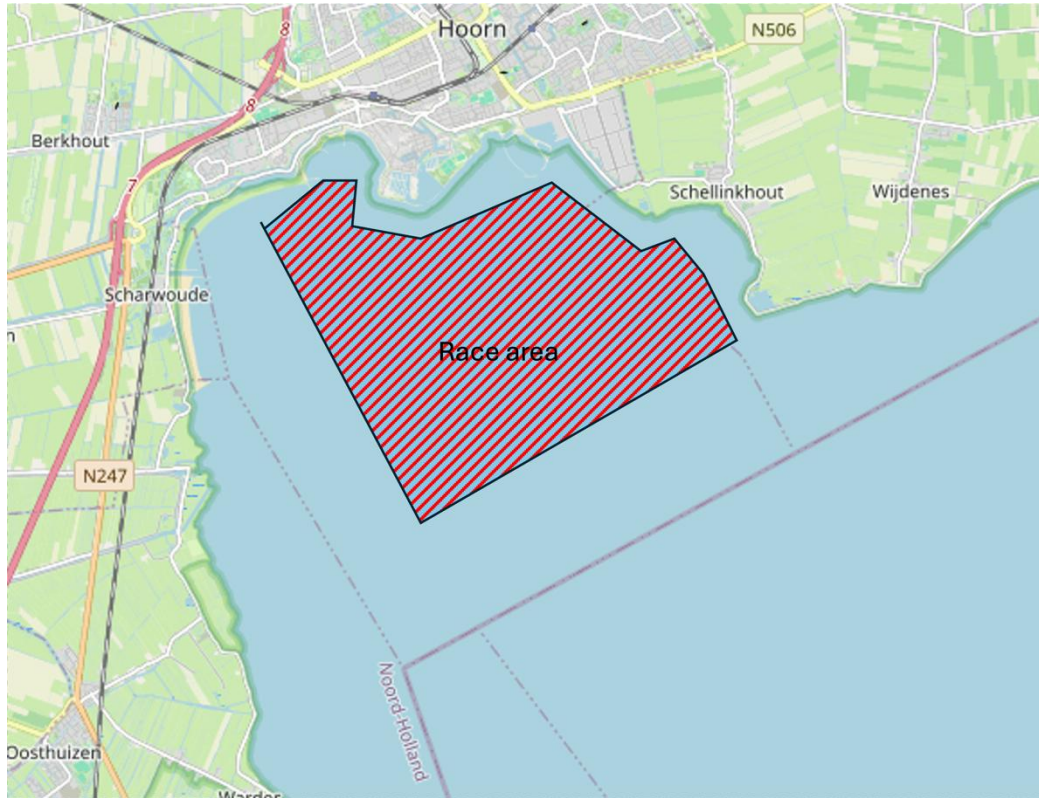


Addendum A: the map of the event venue:






Addendum B: the location of the racing area:
